

<u>"The shot heard round the world"</u> is a phrase that refers to the first shot fired at the battles of Lexington and Concord in April of 1775 which sparked the Revolutionary War. That war brought the tyrannical rule of England to an end for the newly formed United States of America.

This April, we remember three <u>"shouts heard round the world"</u> 2,000 years ago.

<u>The first shout</u> is described in this way in Matthew 21:9 NKJV; <u>Then the multitudes who went</u> before and those who followed cried out, saying "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem was heralded by shouts of praise by the crowds. A few days later, most of those same people were crying out for His crucifixion because they expected a warrior king to free them from the tyranny of Rome, not a king of love, compassion, and forgiveness.

<u>The second shout</u> is described this way in John 19:30 NKJV; <u>So, when Jesus had received the</u> sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

Jesus had fulfilled and finished God's plan to forgive the sin of the world by dying on the cross; a sacrifice we could not make on our own. His sacrifice brings an end to the rule of sin in our life, if only we believe.

<u>The third shout</u> is described this way in Luke 24:4B-5C NKJV; <u>Two men stood by them in</u> <u>shining garments</u>. Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, they said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen!"

Not only were believer's sins paid for at the cross; the promise of eternal life for those same believers is guaranteed by the shout, <u>"He is risen!"</u> It brings the fear of death to an end. We will be with Jesus in heaven some day!

So this season and every season of life, remember the words of this song:

"Shout to the Lord all the earth, let us sing, power and majesty, praise to the King."

Always remember to pray for those whose lives are not as blessed as your own.
