FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The month of July starts with a bang, literally. Fireworks, picnics with hot dogs, barbeque, potato salad, and watermelon are the staples of our Independence Day celebrations. But many people don't realize that our independence from bondage to England wasn't official until 7 years after it was declared.

The Continental Congress voted in favor of independence on July 2, 1776. Two days later, July 4, 1776, delegates from the 13 colonies adopted the Declaration of Independence. But it wasn't official until the United States of America was declared a free and independent country on September 3, 1783.

Between July 4, 1776 and September 3, 1783, years of bloody conflict took place to gain the independence we so cherish.

Aren't you glad that our independence from the bondage of sin doesn't have to be voted on or gained by years of conflict? Jesus took care of all of those details on the cross. When we surrender our life to him, we are instantly freed from the slavery of sin. A Roman jailer once asked Paul and Silas, "What must I do to be saved?" Their answer was, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved....and immediately he was baptized." (Acts 16:30-33).

The free and independent nation that we love will someday disappear, along with all other earthly kingdoms at the end of time as we know it, but our freedom from sin is eternal. "So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed." (John 8:36).

Celebrate the freedom that we have as Americans, which was gained and has been protected by the sacrifice of many. At the same time, be thankful for the eternal freedom from sin that every Christian has, that was gained by the sacrifice of God's only Son.
