

BE STILL

A day or two ago, right before dark, Cissy and I were sitting on the back porch. There was a light breeze that made it very comfortable, and it kept the mosquitos away also. There was no sound other than an occasional bawl from a cow or two; other than that, silence. It made me think of two things.

- 1) It took me back over 60 years to the back steps of my Grannie and Papa's house; I stayed with them for a couple of weeks every summer. After the evening chores were done and the remnants of supper put away, we would sit on the back steps, talk a little, and listen a lot. When we weren't talking, the only sounds were a couple of cows bawling in the mesquite pasture, and a squeaking windmill that belonged to their closest neighbor about a ¼ mile away. Oh, how I treasure those sweet memories.
- 2) It also made me think of <u>Psalm 46:10; "Be still and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." That 46th Psalm begins this way; "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble."</u>

We have been forced to stop and just listen for the past few weeks, and will continue to do so for an undetermined amount of time. Who are we listening to? What are we listening for?

I have heard many people question if we will ever get back to where we were before we ever heard of COVID-19.

I pray that we don't **EVER** get back to <u>"normal"</u>. As individuals, as communities, and as a nation, we have lived as a "take charge" society. We do anything and everything without ever stopping and listening to what God has to say about it, because <u>we never ask for His opinion or His advice.</u>
