From the Pastor's Pen ...

In 2010, the Institute for Business and Home Safety conducted a test. They constructed two, 1300 sq. ft. houses inside of a \$40,000,000 lab. The first home was built according to conventional standards. The second house included steel reinforcement straps that were connected from the foundation to every level, including the roof.

Giant fans were turned on to blow 110 mph winds on the two houses for less than 10 minutes; both houses survived. Then, the fans were turned again for over 10 minutes. The conventional house began to shake and then collapsed. The home that was secured to the foundation received only cosmetic damage.

The experiment reminds us of what Jesus said in Matthew 7:24-27; the house built on the sand, and the house built on the rock. Which house would you rather live in?

The "house" in the Bible story represents our life. Those who live their life according to the world's standards will not stand when storms come. But those whose life is patterned after the life of the "rock", Jesus Christ, will endure through all of life's storms. He is the foundation and the strength of our faith.

As I write this, we are waiting for Hurricane Harvey to come ashore with its rain, wind, and waves; a storm of gigantic proportions. But, because of our faith in Jesus Christ, we need not fear the storms to come, no matter where they come from, or what form they take.
